



Central Vermont Habitat For Humanity (CVHFH) takes the health and safety of its employees and volunteers very seriously. Faced with the spread of the novel coronavirus of 2019 (SARS-Cov-2) and its associated respiratory disease, COVID-19, we all must remain vigilant in mitigating the risks associated with this pandemic. As the understanding of this pandemic and the measures available to mitigate its impact continue to evolve, CVHFH works to follow both state and federal guidance.

Relevant guidance will be posted on all CVHFH sites for reference, and will be updated as the guidance changes. In addition, until further notice CVHFH requires the following:

- All people onsite at a CVHFH project will wear face coverings over the nose and mouth while indoors regardless of vaccination status.
- All people who are eligible and able to be vaccinated are expected to be. CVHFH reserves the right to request proof of vaccination. (A photo of your vaccination card is acceptable.)
 - Fully vaccinated persons are those who are ≥ 14 days postcompletion of the primary series of an FDA-authorized COVID-19 vaccine. Not fully vaccinated persons are those who did not receive an FDA-authorized COVID-19 vaccine or who received vaccine but are not yet considered fully vaccinated.
- All people onsite are expected to be symptom free as defined by the CDC and Vermont Department of Health. Should you display symptoms while onsite, the site supervisor will ask you to leave.

Our top priority remains the health and safety of our staff, volunteers, subcontractors, and the community. We appreciate your understanding and cooperation.
